

## ***Be Filled with the Holy Spirit Part 04***

### ***The First Manifestation of the Holy Spirit Baptism***

### ***and the Impact of the Holy Spirit Baptism***

***“1 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. 2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. 3 And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. 4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.”(Acts 2:1-4 KJV)***

What Jesus had said and promised to the disciples about the coming of the Holy Spirit was fulfilled as we read here that the Holy Spirit fell on them when they were together; for came a sound from Heaven as a rushing mighty wind and appeared to them a cloven tongues like as of fire that sat upon each of them and they started to speak with other tongues. **Therefore continue to pray to God and ask Him to fill you and to baptize you with the Holy Spirit baptism.** The first manifestation of the Holy Spirit Baptism is speaking of other tongues which can be in two forms:

***A. Speaking in tongues in the form of other nations languages:*** To enable the disciples to preach the gospel to other nations and to declare to them the wonderful works of God and that what had happened in the day of Pentecost, ***“5 And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven. 6 Now when this was noised abroad, the multitude came together, and were confounded, because that every man heard them speak in his own language. 7 And they were all amazed and marvelled, saying one to another, Behold, are not all these which speak Galileans? 8 And how hear we every man in our own tongue, wherein we were born? 9 Parthians, and Medes, and Elamites, and the dwellers in Mesopotamia, and in Judaea, and Cappadocia, in Pontus, and Asia, 10 Phrygia, and Pamphylia, in Egypt, and in the parts of Libya about Cyrene, and strangers of Rome, Jews and proselytes, 11 Cretes and Arabians, we do hear them speak in our tongues the wonderful works of God.” (Acts 2:5-11 KJV)*** **Therefore continue to seek the Holy Spirit baptism so that you can declare the gospel of Jesus and the wonderful works of God to other nations around you.**

***B. Speaking in tongues in the form of speaking of tongues of angels:*** As mentioned in ***1 Corinthians 13:1 “Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels,”*** and that kind of speaking in tongues it needs interpretation because that language will not be understandable by men. Therefore when anyone speaks in tongues of angels there must be an interpretation otherwise he needed to be silent or to speak to himself and God as we can read in ***1 Corinthians 14:27-28 “27 If any man speak in an unknown tongue, let it be by two, or at the most by three, and that by course; and let one interpret. 28 But if there be no interpreter, let him keep silence in the church; and let him speak to himself, and to God.”***

To the Jews who were in Jerusalem on the day of Pentecost who heard the apostles speaking with new tongues they accused them being drunk. Therefore Peter in his sermon, explained to them what they saw and heard was what God had promised in the book of Joel, ***“16 But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel; 17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters***

***shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: 18 And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy: 19 And I will shew wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke: 20 The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and notable day of the Lord come: 21 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.” (Acts 2:16-21 KJV)*** And later on Peter addressed to them that this gift of the Holy Spirit is also for them, for their children, and for others if they would be willing to repent, believe in Christ and got water baptized; ***“38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. 39 For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the LORD our God shall call.” (Acts 2: 38-39 KJV)*** Therefore Peter here explained to the Jewish crowd that the ability of speaking in other tongues as the Spirit enables them is the gift of God who would give to those who repent and receive Christ. **Therefore we need to continue to preach the gospel so people will hear and got saved, and we need to speak and expound about the gift of God, the Holy Spirit baptism to those who believe.**

Speaking in tongues is the initial manifestation of the Holy Spirit baptism and we can find that happened in other occasions in the book of Acts as we can read below:

***1. “44 While Peter yet spake these words, the Holy Ghost fell on all them which heard the word. 45 And they of the circumcision which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost. 46 For they heard them speak with tongues, and magnify God. Then answered Peter,” (Acts 10:44-46 KJV)*** Peter was sent by God to the house of Cornelius to give him and his household who was gathered there the message of salvation. As Peter was speaking the message of God to them the gift of the Holy Spirit fell on them for they heard them speaking in tongues. **Therefore we need to continue to preach the gospel and to preach about the Holy Spirit baptism so people will have the opportunity to believe in Christ and got saved, and to receive the Holy Spirit baptism.** Peter when returned to Jerusalem the circumcised believers criticized him and said, ***“3 Saying, Thou wentest in to men uncircumcised, and didst eat with them.” (Acts 11:3)*** Peter began and explained everything to them precisely as it had happened and finally reported to them the following: ***“15 And as I began to speak, the Holy Ghost fell on them, as on us at the beginning. 16 Then remembered I the word of the Lord, how that he said, John indeed baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost. 17 Forasmuch then as God gave them the like gift as he did unto us, who believed on the Lord Jesus Christ; what was I, that I could withstand God? 18 When they heard these things, they held their peace, and glorified God, saying, Then hath God also to the Gentiles granted repentance unto life.” (Acts 11:15-18 KJV)***

***2. “17 And Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and putting his hands on him said, Brother Saul, the Lord, even Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that thou mightest receive thy sight, and be filled with the Holy Ghost. 18 And immediately there fell from his eyes as it had been scales: and he received sight forthwith, and arose, and was baptized. 19 And when he had received meat, he was strengthened. Then was Saul certain days with the disciples which were at Damascus. 20 And straightway he preached Christ in the synagogues, that he is the Son of God.” (Acts 9:17-20 KJV)*** Saul who became Paul upon his repentance he received the gift and was filled

with the Holy Spirit, and we know that Paul was speaking in tongues as himself mentioned that in *1 Corinthians 14:18* ***“18 I thank my God, I speak with tongues more than ye all.”***

***3. “1 And it came to pass, that, while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul having passed through the upper coasts came to Ephesus: and finding certain disciples, 2 He said unto them, Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye believed? And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost. 3 And he said unto them, Unto what then were ye baptized? And they said, Unto John's baptism. 4 Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus. 5 When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. 6 And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied. 7 And all the men were about twelve.” (Acts 19:1-7 KJV)*** That is another occasion mentioned that the baptism of the Holy Spirit manifested by speaking in new tongues. Here the Holy Spirit Baptism happened after the placing of hands of Paul on the disciples. God is the One who baptized the disciple with the Holy Spirit, and God would still baptize the disciple in certain occasions by the placing of hands on them of those who are baptized by the Holy Spirit. **Therefore we need to continue to lay hands on those new disciples whom we baptize in water and pray for them perhaps they will receive the baptism of the Holy Spirit.**

***My dear and beloved:*** If you have not experienced the gift of the Holy Spirit this is the right time for you to repent and trust God fully and commit your ways to Him. Kneel down at His feet and ask Him to baptize you with the Holy Spirit, as agree to pray

***“Father God I commit myself into your hands, Lord I repent from the following sins \_\_\_\_\_ . Lord I want to live my life unto you. Lord I ask you to fill me with your Holy Spirit, this all what I ask and pray in Jesus name, Amen.***

Now we will study the impact of the Holy Spirit baptism on the lives of the disciples. The Holy Spirit that came on the disciples on the day of Pentecost was seen as tongues of fire and heard as a rushing mighty wind. So the Holy Spirit can be seen and can be heard. **Some people they say we felt the Holy Spirit but that is not correct because feelings can mislead us. So we ought to see and hear the Holy Spirit movement in our lives.**

The Holy Spirit who filled the disciples in the day of Pentecost gave them the ability to speak in new tongues to declare the wonders of God in various languages that those who were there heard them speaking in their own languages. ***“6 Now when this was noised abroad, the multitude came together, and were confounded, because that every man heard them speak in his own language. 7 And they were all amazed and marvelled, saying one to another, Behold, are not all these which speak Galileans? 8 And how hear we every man in our own tongue, wherein we were born? 9 Parthians, and Medes, and Elamites, and the dwellers in Mesopotamia, and in Judaea, and Cappadocia, in Pontus, and Asia, 10 Phrygia, and Pamphylia, in Egypt, and in the parts of Libya about Cyrene, and strangers of Rome, Jews and proselytes, 11 Cretes and Arabians, we do hear them speak in our tongues the wonderful works of God.” (Acts 2:6-11 KJV)*** But not only God gave them the languages of different tongue, in addition to that the Holy Spirit baptism gave them the following:

***1. Power:*** To live boldly and courageously testifying to the world the goodness of the Lord. As we know that the disciples were afraid from the persecution of the Jews. They were living

behind locked doors. But when The Holy Spirit filled them He gave them the courage to face a big crowd of Jews without fear testifying to them Jesus’ good news. ***“14 But Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted up his voice, and said unto them, ...” (Acts 2:14 KJV)*** Peter who was timid and denied that he was one of Jesus followers, now, after he was filled with the Holy Spirit he stood up courageously with confidence and addressed the crowd with authority. **In the same way the Holy Spirit will give you the courage to face the people around you with the truth of God’s Word.**

***2/ Wisdom:*** As the Jews heard them speaking in new tongues, ***“13 Others mocking said, These men are full of new wine.” (Acts 2:13 KJV)*** So here the Holy Spirit gave wisdom to the disciples in answering them. ***“14 But Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted up his voice, and said unto them, Ye men of Judaea, and all ye that dwell at Jerusalem, be this known unto you, and hearken to my words: 15 For these are not drunken, as ye suppose, seeing it is but the third hour of the day. 16 But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel; 17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: 18 And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy: 19 And I will shew wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke: 20 The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and notable day of the Lord come: 21 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.” (Acts 2:14-21 KJV)*** The Holy Spirit gave Peter the wisdom how to explain to them the phenomenon of speaking in new tongues they never knew before. The Holy Spirit reminded Peter about the prophecy of the prophet Joel and enabled him to link it with what they experienced. **The Holy Spirit will give you wisdom how to explain to the people and will remind you how to show them the truth from the Scripture.**

***3. Memory:*** The Holy Spirit is a big aid to us and works as memory to remind us about the things that God wants us to remember. Peter knew the prophecy of Joel but the Holy Spirit reminded him at the right time about the exact Word of God that he needed to use to explain to the people. Jesus also spoke about that when He said, ***“26 But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.” (John 14:26 KJV)*** **Therefore trust God that He will remind you about His Word and what you need to share to the people whom you are reaching out with the gospel of Jesus.**

***4. Change the person characters for the Glory of God:*** As we know that Peter was with a shaken personality. Hurry to answer, doing mistakes, having fear, easy to run away, etc. But what we found here is that ***“Peter, standing up with the eleven, lifted up his voice, and said unto them”***, because the Holy Spirit filled him with boldness and confidence to do the work of God. No more fear but He raised his voice and addressed the crowd confidently with the message. **Therefore be strong and courageous; no more fear, trust God and have confidence in Him; stand up and address the people with the message of God.**

***5. Gives us the message:*** For every crowd of people there is a certain message God wants us to speak to them. Baptism with the Holy Spirit would equip us and makes us ready to do that. Peter did not prepare the message at the day of Pentecost but God the Holy Spirit gave Him the message: ***“22 Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of***

*God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know: 23 Him, being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, ye have taken, and by wicked hands have crucified and slain: 24 Whom God hath raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because it was not possible that he should be holden of it. 25 For David speaketh concerning him, I foresaw the Lord always before my face, for he is on my right hand, that I should not be moved: 26 Therefore did my heart rejoice, and my tongue was glad; moreover also my flesh shall rest in hope: 27 Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption. 28 Thou hast made known to me the ways of life; thou shalt make me full of joy with thy countenance. 29 Men and brethren, let me freely speak unto you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his sepulchre is with us unto this day. 30 Therefore being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, he would raise up Christ to sit on his throne; 31 He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption. 32 This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses. 33 Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear. 34 For David is not ascended into the heavens: but he saith himself, The Lord said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, 35 Until I make thy foes thy footstool. 36 Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made the same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ.” (Acts 2:22-36 KJV) Therefore trust God that at the proper time He shall give you the message that you need to deliver to the people.*

**6. Drawing people toward us and direct us to the people to give them the message:** The big crowd of the Jews in Jerusalem was drawn by God to the disciples to hear the message and got convicted by the Holy Spirit to repent, receive Christ and to get water baptized. *“37 Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do? 38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. 39 For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the LORD our God shall call. 40 And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation. 41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls.” (Acts 2:37-41 KJV)* God would prime the hearts of the people; He would bring to us or bring us to them, and make them ready to hear the message from our mouths. *Therefore be open to the Holy Spirit and let Him lead you to the crowd that He wants you to preach the gospel to them, and also be open to the people that the Holy Spirit is sending to you to preach His Word to them.*

**7. Our Mission Organizer:** *“15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.” (Mark 16:15-16 KJV)* To be filled with the Holy Spirit is not a luxurious thing that you can live and achieve the goals of God in your life without it. But is an essential and mandatory for what God had entrust to you from mission in your life. Jesus commissioned us to go to the whole world and preach the gospel. But we cannot go and do His work unless He is with us. The only possible way that He is with us and will be with us and we can do His will and serve Him properly is when we are filled with the Holy Spirit

Jesus also said the following to His apostles: *“17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.” (Mark 16:17-18 KJV)* These privileges will appear in the life of those disciples only when they are filled with the Holy Spirit. *Therefore you need to be filled with the Holy Spirit so you can do the mission work of God and for the following more purposes:*

**8. Driving out demons:** Jesus drove out demons with the Holy Spirit. *“22 Then was brought unto him one possessed with a devil, blind, and dumb: and he healed him, insomuch that the blind and dumb both spake and saw. 23 And all the people were amazed, and said, Is not this the son of David? 24 But when the Pharisees heard it, they said, This fellow doth not cast out devils, but by Beelzebub the prince of the devils. 25 And Jesus knew their thoughts, and said unto them, Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation; and every city or house divided against itself shall not stand: 26 And if Satan cast out Satan, he is divided against himself; how shall then his kingdom stand? 27 And if I by Beelzebub cast out devils, by whom do your children cast them out? therefore they shall be your judges. 28 But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.” (Matthew 12:22-28 KJV)* In Luke 11:20 Jesus called the Holy Spirit the finger of God, *“But if I with the finger of God cast out devils, no doubt the kingdom of God is come upon you.”* In our mission to preach the gospel we will face demons and the power of darkness opposing us and we can overcome them only if we are filled with the Holy Spirit and having the finger of God with us. The following are some more examples we can read about the work of The Holy Spirit in driving out demons in the life of the first century church.

**A.** *“6 And when they had gone through the isle unto Paphos, they found a certain sorcerer, a false prophet, a Jew, whose name was Barjesus: 7 Which was with the deputy of the country, Sergius Paulus, a prudent man; who called for Barnabas and Saul, and desired to hear the word of God. 8 But Elymas the sorcerer (for so is his name by interpretation) withstood them, seeking to turn away the deputy from the faith. 9 Then Saul, (who also is called Paul,) filled with the Holy Ghost, set his eyes on him. 10 And said, O full of all subtilty and all mischief, thou child of the devil, thou enemy of all righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord? 11 And now, behold, the hand of the Lord is upon thee, and thou shalt be blind, not seeing the sun for a season. And immediately there fell on him a mist and a darkness; and he went about seeking some to lead him by the hand. 12 Then the deputy, when he saw what was done, believed, being astonished at the doctrine of the Lord.” (Acts 13:6-12 KJV)*

**B.** *“16 And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying: 17 The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation. 18 And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour.” (Acts 16:16-18 KJV)* Again Paul drove out another demon that was troubling their mission. *Therefore let us trust God that as we are filled with the Holy Spirit then we are able to drive out demons and to deal with the power of darkness.*



**9. Protection:** The Holy Spirit will be the one to protect us from all the works of devil and demons. The Holy Spirit that we are filled with may even protect us from sicknesses and even poisons. *“1 And when they were escaped, then they knew that the island was called Melita. 2 And the barbarous people shewed us no little kindness: for they kindled a fire, and received us every one, because of the present rain, and because of the cold. 3 And when Paul had gathered a bundle of sticks, and laid them on the fire, there came a viper out of the heat, and fastened on his hand. 4 And when the barbarians saw the venomous beast hang on his hand, they said among themselves, No doubt this man is a murderer, whom, though he hath escaped the sea, yet vengeance suffereth not to live. 5 And he shook off the beast into the fire, and felt no harm. 6 Howbeit they looked when he should have swollen, or fallen down dead suddenly: but after they had looked a great while, and saw no harm come to him, they changed their minds, and said that he was a god.”* (Acts 28:1-6 KJV) Paul was protected from the poisonous snake’s bite. **Therefore as we are filled with the Holy Spirit let us trust God that He will deliver us and protect us from the works of Satan and demons.**

**10. The Holy Spirit is our advocator and our defender against the schemes and the weapons of Satan:** *“3 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: 4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) 5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ; 6 And having in a readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your obedience is fulfilled.”* (2 Corinthians 10:3-6 KJV) **You can do that and overcome the power of darkness when you are filled with the Holy Spirit whom God will give to you as you obey Him.**

**11. Healing from sicknesses:** As we are filled with the Holy Spirit people would receive healing when we lay hands on them and pray in the name of Jesus. *“7 In the same quarters were possessions of the chief man of the island, whose name was Publius; who received us, and lodged us three days courteously. 8 And it came to pass, that the father of Publius lay sick of a fever and of a bloody flux: to whom Paul entered in, and prayed, and laid his hands on him, and healed him. 9 So when this was done, others also, which had diseases in the island, came, and were healed: 10 Who also honoured us with many honours; and when we departed, they laded us with such things as were necessary.”* (Acts 28:7-10 KJV) **Therefore never loss any opportunity to lay hands on sick people and pray for them to be healed; for God shall do miracles of healing through your life and ministry.**

*“19 So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. 20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.”* (Mark 16:19-20 KJV) As the disciples received the Holy Spirit baptism then the Lord was with them and that is why they were able to go out and to preach everywhere. **The same for you as you seek to be filled with the Holy Spirit then you will be changed and you will be able to do all that for God.**

**My Dear and Beloved:** Come now to the Lord and commit your life for Him so He will fill you with the Holy Spirit that will give you power, wisdom, memory, change you to another person for God’s service, give you the message, drawing you toward people or draw people to you, organize your mission, helping you driving out demons, healing the sick, protecting you

from the power of darkness and from sicknesses, and will be with you and work with you in doing your ministry.

**Let us pray ....**

**My Prayer:** Father God, I come before you in the name of Jesus, who died on the cross for my sins and rose from the dead to give me eternal life. Lord, thank you for the teaching and the encouraging Word that I received in this message and all your good promises to me about the Baptism of the Holy Spirit.

Come now to God and confess and renounce all your sins. Confess and renounce all the works of the flesh in your life; telling lies, stealing, fights, anger, rage, hatred, revenge, unforgiveness, grudge and bitterness, division, envy, jealousy, murder, lust, immoralities, greed, injustice, corruption, worldliness, and your love for money and material things. Confess and renounce all your stubbornness, disobedience and delay obedience. Confess and renounce your bad stewardship, your bad example and your non willingness to serve God and suffer for Him. Confess and renounce your lack of faith and the doubts in your mind. Confess and renounce your yoke with non believers, and in bondage with the Media, News and games. Confess and renounce your lack of reading God’s Word and life of prayers. Lord forgive me, I repent of the following sins \_\_\_\_\_.

Lord baptize me with the Holy Spirit, equip me by giving me the spiritual gifts so that I can serve you, tell others about your salvation, do all the mission’ work and the ministry that you entrusted to me to do; to heal the sick by laying on of my hands on them, to drive out demons, to preach the gospel and to give your message to them.

Lord thank you for my Brothers and Sisters who repented of their sins, and committed their lives to live and apply what you send us in this message. Lord baptize them with the Holy Spirit; let them speaks in tongues and give them the spiritual gifts that they need to go on and serve you. Lord use them to do your work and ministry. Lord protect them from the evil ones and provide their needs, give them courage, wisdom, boldness, take their fears away, give them the message they need to preach and work with them in doing their ministries.

Lord, bless us as your church. Lord we commit ourselves to teach and preach about the baptism of the Holy Spirit and to lay hands on our disciples and children that they will be filled with the Holy Spirit who will carry further your mission.
