

## *The Future of our Children is in our Hands Part 1*

*“1 In the third year of the reign of Jehoiakim king of Judah came Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon unto Jerusalem, and besieged it. 2 And the Lord gave Jehoiakim king of Judah into his hand, with part of the vessels of the house of God: which he carried into the land of Shinar to the house of his god; and he brought the vessels into the treasure house of his god. 3 And the king spake unto Ashpenaz the master of his eunuchs, that he should bring certain of the children of Israel, and of the king's seed, and of the princes; 4 Children in whom was no blemish, but well favoured, and skilful in all wisdom, and cunning in knowledge, and understanding science, and such as had ability in them to stand in the king's palace, and whom they might teach the learning and the tongue of the Chaldeans. 5 And the king appointed them a daily provision of the king's meat, and of the wine which he drank: so nourishing them three years, that at the end thereof they might stand before the king. 6 Now among these were of the children of Judah, Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah: 7 Unto whom the prince of the eunuchs gave names: for he gave unto Daniel the name of Belteshazzar; and to Hananiah, of Shadrach; and to Mishael, of Meshach; and to Azariah, of Abednego.” (Daniel 1:1-7 KJV)*

From what we read, then we expect that God would defend Jehoiakim and rescue him from the hand of Nebuchadnezzar, but we found here the opposite that God handed over Jehoiakim into the hand of his enemies the Babylonians. Why God did such? The Scripture tells us the following: *“36 Jehoiakim was twenty and five years old when he began to reign; and he reigned eleven years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Zebudah, the daughter of Pedaiah of Rumah. 37 And he did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his fathers had done.” (2 Kings 23:36-37 KJV)* Because Jehoiakim did that which was evil in the sight of God, that was why God handed him over to his enemies. The temple of God and their lives were full of idols and sins and that is why God allowed such to happen.

God had made to them pattern in their lives that they needed to follow. In the Law of Moses all aspects of their lives were included and they needed to abide and be restricted with. **Even to us today we are restricted and we cannot do our own. That is why we read the Bible and study the Word of God and apply in our lives so we will not sin against God.**

*“1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 2 Speak unto Aaron, and unto his sons, and unto all the children of Israel, and say unto them; This is the thing which the LORD hath commanded, saying, 3 What man soever there be of the house of Israel, that killeth an ox, or lamb, or goat, in the camp, or that killeth it out of the camp, 4 And bringeth it not unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, to offer an offering unto the LORD before the tabernacle of the LORD; blood shall be imputed unto that man; he hath shed blood; and that man shall be cut off from among his people: 5 To the end that the children of Israel may bring their sacrifices, which they offer in the open field, even that they may bring them unto the LORD, unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, unto the priest, and offer them for peace offerings unto the LORD. 6 And the priest shall sprinkle the blood upon the altar of the LORD at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and burn the fat for a sweet savour unto the LORD. 7 And they shall no more offer their sacrifices unto devils, after whom they have gone a whoring. This shall be a statute for ever unto them throughout their generations.” (Leviticus 17:1-7 KJV)* Here God told them no more that they will do their own but to bring their sacrifices to the tabernacle of the congregation where

the priests working and who were observing the law of God. Before Moses gave them the law of God they were doing their own and they were offering their sacrifices in the open field or in the camp and which were considered offered to demons, but after they received the law of God they cannot continue to do their own but to come to the priests who would check their offerings and what for they were represented their sacrifices to God. Therefore they could not tell to the priest it is my son birthday or it is Christmas, a New Year celebration, it is farewell party, or Father Day, Molech Day, Ashtarothe Day, Halloween Day, Valentine Day, or it is our wedding anniversary and so on. The priests were in the tabernacle of the congregation not for such and they would not allow such non sense to happen.

The same here for us in God's church we are not for such things of idol origin and entertainment. We as a church, we teach you the Word of God and put rules from the Scriptures that all of us need to follow. The question is ‘To whom you are offering the parts of your body?’ *“1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.” (Romans 12:1 KJV)* Even small things it matter, like birthdays greetings, watching non sense in YOU tube, putting make up, having boyfriend, having girlfriend, etc, all such offerings are to demons and not to God as we read, *“7 And they shall no more offer their sacrifices unto devils, after whom they have gone a whoring. This shall be a statute for ever unto them throughout their generations.” (Leviticus 17:7 KJV)* In doing such you are in spiritual adultery having gone whoring with demons, and so therefore you will reach and be bitten by the fire of hell. Please mark in your Bible **Leviticus 17:7**, and put in your mind that whatever you offer things which are contrary to Scripture then you are offering them to demons.

*“8 And thou shalt say unto them, Whatsoever man there be of the house of Israel, or of the strangers which sojourn among you, that offereth a burnt offering or sacrifice, 9 And bringeth it not unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, to offer it unto the LORD; even that man shall be cut off from among his people.” (Leviticus 17:8-9 KJV)* That is why we are always teaching and putting rules based on God's Word, and removing those things from our church that offered to demons. You may say they are small things, and why our pastor or our church is so strict about it, or why other churches they allow. But the Scripture say they are offered and done to demons. The American church started with those small things but the small things became big and the big became giants and now they are so advanced in things offered to demons, up to the point they reached to homosexual and transgender marriages.

I am not strict but I am applying God's Word. There were some even to the point they prayed for me to be less strict, and even to remove me as their pastor and even until today. Such prayers are offered to demons and not to God. I am attacked by demons every now and then, but I will continue to obey God and I will not compromise with anyone. If anyone disobey, that does not mean I am approving such a person or compromised with such a one, but he or she disobeying God and he or she will receive the consequences of such a sin. **And the following is my instruction and warning to such a person: Listen if you will not repent God finally shall hand you over to your enemies as He handed over Jehoiakim and Judah to their enemies, the Babylonians.**

Listen to me Church of God Tennessee Cleveland if you will not repent God shall not only hand you over to your enemies, but He shall hand you over to demons even in hell if you persist in idol worship, immoralities and tolerating the homosexual and the transgender.

The future of our children is in our hands therefore repent of all your sins so your children will not happen to them what had happened to Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah. They were taken captive, slaves in other country, away from their families, they even changed their names from names that glorified God to names that glorified man and demons

All their names were linked to God but they changed to worldly names and what glorify man and demons. Imagine you named your son and raise him Joshua then they will call him Krishna, or you named your son Daniel and they will call him Buddha, or Joseph and they will name him Mohammed. **Very painful and humiliating event, but God allowed it for the sin of His people. They allowed idols and demons in their lives and so idols and demons came back to attack their children.** The meaning of Daniel is ‘*God is my judge*’, and they gave him the name ‘Belteshazzar’, which means ‘*who is pleased with and kept by the god bel*’, this was a demon the Babylonians worshipped, which was the god of Nebuchadnezzar as we can conclude from ***Daniel 4:8, “But at the last Daniel came in before me, whose name was Belteshazzar, according to the name of my God, and in whom is the spirit of the holy gods: and before him I told the dream, saying,”*** The meaning of Hananiah is ‘*God has mercy*’ or ‘*strengthened by his God*’, and they gave him the name ‘Shadrach’, which means ‘*the one strengthen by rach*’ and rach is the name of the sun god, and this same sun god the Catholic church took and incorporated inside the church as Christmas. The meaning of Mishael is ‘*Who is what God is*’, and they gave him the name ‘Meshach’; which means ‘*who is like ach*’ and ach means the Venus god, the god of the feminists. It might be a female name and Mishael was a boy and named him with a girl name. The meaning of Azariah is ‘*Jehovah has helped*’, they gave him the name ‘Abednego’, which means ‘*servant of Nebo*’, a name of another god of the Babylonians. So totally were different names that will take away God’s name from the court of king Nebuchadnezzar and linked their names with demons. **The church should teach and explain such from the Scripture to make it clear to the parents what will be the outcome of their worldliness, compromises and their offering to idols and demons and their bad effects on their children, descendants and the generation to come. The church who refuse to teach such is a prostitute church.**

How we expect, and for what that they will call Daniel, ‘*God is my judge*’, or Hananiah ‘*God has mercy*’ or ‘*strengthen by his God*’, or Mishael, ‘*Who is what God is*’, or Azariah, ‘*Jehovah has helped*’, in the court of Nebuchadnezzar if the Babylonians had already destroyed the Temple of God and demolished the walls of Jerusalem, and brought all the vessels of the temple to the house of their god, and God allowed that because of the sin of His people. So now they wanted to remove the name of God from the court of Nebuchadnezzar that is why they changed their names.

Their children were taken away from them and ended up in exile in Babylon. \* **The following is what I say to those who boast who sent their children to live in UK, USA, Canada, etc, thinking that is the best: That is not but the curse of God on them to bereave them of their children. I am not saying such to others but only to those who boast with their worldliness and that their children in such places, who they are not but in the courts of men and demons. \* We are called not to send our children to such places but to raise them in a Godly way to reach Heaven.**

And what kinds of struggles those children of the Jewish passed through? They were about to eat food offered to idols, to drink wine, they changed their names and linked them with

demons, they needed to tell the dream of Nebuchadnezzar and to explain it to save their lives, they needed to worship the image that the king erected otherwise they will be thrown into the furnace, and they needed to pray to the king for one month and not to God otherwise they will be thrown in the den of lions. **Terrible life and trials they passed through because of the idol worship and the disobedience of their parents and their forefathers; and that is the terrible future that you are preparing for your children if you will not repent and behave.**

**The future of our children is in our hands that is why you too need to repent and behave so that your children will not suffer such a cruel end.**

We spoke about Jehoiakim which he did evil, now we will speak about another person, King Hezekiah who did which was right in the sight of God. ***“1 Now it came to pass in the third year of Hoshea son of Elah king of Israel, that Hezekiah the son of Ahaz king of Judah began to reign. 2 Twenty and five years old was he when he began to reign; and he reigned twenty and nine years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also was Abi, the daughter of Zachariah. 3 And he did that which was right in the sight of the LORD, according to all that David his father did.” (2 King 18:1-3 KJV)*** Hezekiah was delivered from the army of the Assyrian; God also healed him and added 15 more years to his life. But let us read how he behaved when the Babylonians sent their ambassadors to congratulate him for the healing he received. ***“12 At that time Berodachbaladan, the son of Baladan, king of Babylon, sent letters and a present unto Hezekiah: for he had heard that Hezekiah had been sick. 13 And Hezekiah hearkened unto them, and shewed them all the house of his precious things, the silver, and the gold, and the spices, and the precious ointment, and all the house of his armour, and all that was found in his treasures: there was nothing in his house, nor in all his dominion, that Hezekiah shewed them not. 14 Then came Isaiah the prophet unto king Hezekiah, and said unto him, What said these men? and from whence came they unto thee? And Hezekiah said, They are come from a far country, even from Babylon. 15 And he said, What have they seen in thine house? And Hezekiah answered, All the things that are in mine house have they seen: there is nothing among my treasures that I have not shewed them.” (2 Kings 20:12-15 KJV)*** Here when you read that you may not see in such any bad but only what was good. And I tell you if you will not read after, and if it is not written we may not see in what he did anything bad. But Hezekiah according to the Scripture what he did was out of boasting and showing off and showed how he was so worldly. He did not tell them about God and how He had delivered him and healed him but boasted of what he had. Also God left him alone to check what was inside him and for his true color to appear, ***“31 Howbeit in the business of the ambassadors of the princes of Babylon, who sent unto him to enquire of the wonder that was done in the land, God left him, to try him, that he might know all that was in his heart.” (2 Chronicles 32:31 KJV)*** Hezekiah sent for the prophet Isaiah when the Assyrians came to attack him with their army. Isaiah also was with him when he was sick and about to die, but here he did not send for him. Why? Because he knew that Isaiah will tell him ‘No! Hezekiah don’t do such’. \* **The same style of Isaiah I follow: ‘No! Don’t do such’. No party, no celebration, don’t show off, and the rest of my long list of ‘Do not’. That is why some they don’t approach me because they know my answer. \* If you see someone behaving like Hezekiah don’t think that I approved such, but he or she is just doing his or her own.** God also did not send the prophet Isaiah at the beginning but he sent him after they left him so what was inside him will come out. Once they leave the church I can see their true color, I can see on their facebook, Merry Christmas, happy birthday, the Christmas tree and taking photo with the tree, the lipstick, the make up, the naked dress, eating in restaurants, the boasting, etc. For them the church is a prison because they cannot offer their lives to

demons because we don't allow them to do their own. So when they will leave they live the freedom. *\* But what kind of freedom, and what follow after are the troubles; their saving will decrease because they will spend their money on their idols, they will withhold their tithes and offerings and so the devourer will enter their lives and ultimately they will enter into borrowing and debt, and will endorse all such kinds of troubles to their children as what had happened to Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah. \* This is also how poverty developed when people leave the ways of God and follow demons, then they will loss their treasures that God gave them and will end up in poverty that they will endorse to their descendents.*

Hezekiah was rebuked by the prophet Isaiah who told him and prophesied to him the consequences of such sin which was small in the eyes of Hezekiah as I am rebuking you for your sins and some of you are belittling my admonishments to them. And put also in your mind that the small things will become big and the big will become giants. Let us read what Isaiah told him: *"16 And Isaiah said unto Hezekiah, Hear the word of the LORD. 17 Behold, the days come, that all that is in thine house, and that which thy fathers have laid up in store unto this day, shall be carried into Babylon: nothing shall be left, saith the LORD. 18 And of thy sons that shall issue from thee, which thou shalt beget, shall they take away; and they shall be eunuchs in the palace of the king of Babylon."* (2 Kings 20:16-18 KJV), and that truly happened of what was written and we read in *Daniel 1:1-7*. They took all the treasures in Jerusalem and the vessels in the temple of God and brought to the house of the god of Nebuchadnezzar in Babylon. They took also the nobles of Jerusalem and the royal seeds, that is why we can now understand why God handed over Jehoiakim king of Judah, the vessels of the house of God, the children of Israel, and of the king's seed, and of the princes, of the children of Judah, among whom were Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah, into the hands of the Babylonians who will be eunuchs which means officials in the court of the king of Babylon. *I tell you the truth, if you will not repent your money, your treasures and your children will be given to demons and to your enemies and finally you will end up in hell.*

Hezekiah was so selfish and did not think that his disobedience of what he did was against God who did not want him to show his treasures to the Babylonian. Even after that he belittled the warning of Isaiah the prophet that such of what he did had opened the door of troubles to all the kingdom of Judah, to his princes and to his seed. *Even today all the rebukes and the admonishments that you are receiving from me based on God's Word for your sins and wrong doings and you belittle them, such attitude will open the door of troubles to you and for your children and descendent after you. Don't be selfish, your disregards to the admonishments and corrections will bring the harm to your descendents as what happened to the descendents of Hezekiah.*

Hezekiah did not repent of his boasting and he disrespectfully answered back the prophet Isaiah who helped him much in times of his troubles, but when he was relieved he started to do his own and did not send for Isaiah to ask his opinion when the ambassadors came to visit him, and when the prophet rebuked him he despised that rebuke with his boastful answer, *"19 Then said Hezekiah unto Isaiah, Good is the word of the LORD which thou hast spoken. And he said, Is it not good, if peace and truth be in my days?"* (2 King 20:19 KJV). With what he answered back showed that he was boasting; he said that he was blessed with peace during his time but did not consider what will happen to the next generations and his descendents. He did not consider repenting of what he did wrong in what he behaved with the ambassadors of the Babylonians and even with his pride and his disrespect to the man of God who warned him. Therefore, after the rebuke of Isaiah and Hezekiah did not repent of it God

fulfilled His Word at the end of the rule of Jehoiakim. According to my calculation from the Scripture, it happened after 110 years. The wrong doing of Hezekiah of what he did it might look small in his eyes and in peoples' eyes, and may be even small in your eyes also but it was big in the sight of God. It was not the fault of Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah but it was the fault of their fathers and forefathers. *Therefore repent so you children and your grandchildren and your descendents will not suffer destruction and havoc.*

I had received much more like what the prophet Isaiah received from Hezekiah. Many were good in answering me back, with disrespect, with insult, with belittling, and mocking, but my concern is what will happen to them and to their children, and this is my concern today in this message.

***My Dear and Beloved:** Your small sin of having friends, putting make up, watching facebook, making small party, little boasting, having boyfriend, having girlfriend, telling lies, celebrating things not in the calendar of God they are abominable in the sight of God. Also as we said the small will become big and the big will become giants and more deterioration in holiness and into the road of corruption and compromises and such will bring the wrath of God on you.*

Take heed of the message and repent so your children, your grandchildren and your descendents shall not suffer. Consider seriously the warning message, repent and amend your ways before too late, so the wrath of God shall not come upon you. The future of your children is in your hands. Repent and behave. Come now and offer your life to God. *Let us pray . . . .*

***My prayer:** Father God I come before you in the name of Jesus who died on the cross for my sins, who was buried and rose from death to give me eternal life. Lord thank you for your Word that admonished me to repent and to amend my ways and renounce my sins so that the future of my children, grandchildren and descendents will be secured. Lord thank you for your goodness and faithfulness and thank you for all your blessings in my life. Lord thank you for all the rebukes and the corrections that I received in this message.*

*Now repent and renounce all your sins. Repent and renounce your delay obedience and partial obedience. Repent of your pride, boasting and showing off. Repent of your selfishness and lack of your concern to the next generation. Repent and renounce your worldliness and doing your own will and plan and not the will and the plan of God. Repent and renounce your lust and your immoralities, your idol worship and your spiritual adultery and offering to demons. Repent and renounce all your compromises, corruption, greed and the rest of your idols. Repent and renounce your lack of praying and reading the Bible. Repent of being yoked with non believers and spending much time with your friends, and on the Media, News and games. Repent of being bad example, having wrong choices and bad stewardship, and your non willingness to serve God and suffer for Him. Lord forgive me, I repent and renounce the following sins \_\_\_\_\_.*

*Lord I commit myself to implement what I learned from this message, that I will keep walking in the narrow way that you ordained for me to pass through. Lord I commit myself to do your will and your plan for me. Lord I commit myself to teach my family and children your Word and your ways. Lord I trust you that as I obey you and raise up my children in the fear of you that you give the good future to my children and protect them and provide for them.*



*Lord, thank you for my Brothers and Sisters who realized their sins and repented from them and committed their lives to do your will and serve you and live the style of life that you want them to live. Lord answer their prayers, protect them, help them to pass the trials that they are facing in their lives, and provide all their needs so they will continue to serve you. Lord use their lives as a testimony to others to follow you. Lord I pray that you will continue to discipline those individuals and the churches who are disobedient to you and those who are living and doing their own will so they will repent and will fear you.*

*Lord bless us as your church, and help us to continue to teach your Word and to implement your commands in the life of our members, workers, families and congregations. Lord refill us with the Holy Spirit and give us the Spiritual gifts that we need in our lives to go on and evangelize, and make disciples and train workers to go and plant new Bible studies and congregations for the church. Lord fulfill the vision of the church, 'Multiplication in peace with implementing the Whole will of God.' Lord take the message and spread it to bring the fruits you desire. Lord bless us, enlarge our territory, let your hand be with us and free us from harm so that we will not feel pain. May the grace of the Lord Jesus and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with us all in Jesus name, Amen.*
