## Watch and Continue to Do the Task As you are Watching for the Coming Judgment of God Part 3

"5 And as some spake of the temple, how it was adorned with goodly stones and gifts, he said, 6 As for these things which ye behold, the days will come, in the which there shall not be left one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down. 7 And they asked him, saying, Master, but when shall these things be? and what sign will there be when these things shall come to pass? 8 And he said, Take heed that ye be not deceived: for many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and the time draweth near: go ye not therefore after them. 9 But when ye shall hear of wars and commotions, be not terrified: for these things must first come to pass; but the end is not by and by, 10 Then said he unto them, Nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: 11 And great earthquakes shall be in divers places, and famines, and pestilences; and fearful sights and great signs shall there be from heaven. 12 But before all these, they shall lay their hands on you, and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues, and into prisons, being brought before kings and rulers for my name's sake. 13 And it shall turn to you for a testimony. 14 Settle it therefore in your hearts, not to meditate before what ye shall answer: 15 For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist. 16 And ye shall be betrayed both by parents, and brethren, and kinsfolks, and friends; and some of you shall they cause to be put to death. 17 And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake. 18 But there shall not an hair of your head perish. 19 In your patience possess ye your souls. 20 And when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies, then know that the desolation thereof is nigh. 21 Then let them which are in Judaea flee to the mountains; and let them which are in the midst of it depart out; and let not them that are in the countries enter thereinto. 22 For these be the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled. 23 But woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck, in those days! for there shall be great distress in the land, and wrath upon this people. 24 And they shall fall by the edge of the sword, and shall be led away captive into all nations; and Jerusalem shall be trodden down of the Gentiles, until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled. 25 And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring; 26 Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken. 27 And then shall they see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. 28 And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh. 29 And he spake to them a parable; Behold the fig tree, and all the trees; 30 When they now shoot forth, we see and know of your own selves that summer is now nigh at hand. 31 So likewise ye, when ye see these things come to pass, know ye that the kingdom of God is nigh at hand. 32 Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass away, till all be fulfilled. 33 Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away. 34 And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares. 35 For as a snare shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth, 36 Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man." (Luke 21:5-36 KJV)

The Scriptures speaks about the coming judgment of God on those who refuse to obey God and His Word. As had happened to the Jewish who refused to believe in Jesus, that the Lord sent His judgment on them and destroyed Jerusalem by the Romans army, it will even happen today, that God will send His wrath to those who refuse to obey Christ and His Word.

- "5 And as some spake of the temple, how it was adorned with goodly stones and gifts, he said," (Luke 21:5 KJV) The temple with its building was attractive to the peoples' eyes and mind. The people at the time of Jesus and even His disciples were attracted toward that. Even today, many people today they love to see big building, especially for the church and they will admire it and adore it, forgetting to focus on the important spiritual principles that God would like to see in the life of the church. Jesus at that time He has no building of His own to gather the disciples, but those who rejected Christ and His Word, they were having and running good facilities, but they were non willing to follow Christ and His Word. Even today there are many with great buildings and facilities in pertain to Christ but they are not willing to follow Christ and abide in His Word.
- "6 As for these things which ye behold, the days will come, in the which there shall not be left one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down." (Luke 21:6 KJV) As Jesus heard them saying admiring Word for the temple, He made it a point and teaching to them, that what they were seeing, one day will come that there will be no stone be left upon another that shall not be thrown. Jesus prophesied to them the total destruction of the place. That was a shocking prophecy of Jesus to His disciples. They were not expecting to hear that and might even never come to their minds that this will happen.
- "7 And they asked him, saying, Master, but when shall these things be? and what sign will there be when these things shall come to pass?" (Luke 21:7 KJV) Therefore when they heard that they asked Him which time this will be fulfilled and what are the signs there be when these things will take place. So now the disciples of Jesus were aware that God will judge the wickedness of the Jewish church that was refusing the Word of God. Even today the time will come that God will judge the churches that do not honor the Word of Christ and who do not follow His instructions. When the disciples asked the Lord "but when shall these things be?" They were asking about which time that the temple will be destroyed, and they were not asking about His second coming. They were asking Him which time that He will judge the Jewish nation for their non believe. Even today we are asking God and waiting which time He will judge His church and His people who refuse to comply with His Word and do His will.

Jesus in answering to them about the time that this will take place, He gave them events that they will be passing through before this will take place. He gave them their assignments that they need to achieve to prove themselves accountable and worthy to escape the coming wrath of God to destroy the Jerusalem and the temple of God. Even today God wants us to live worth and accountable to the calling that He called us to live so that we will escape His judgment on those who are disobedient.

"8 And he said, Take heed that ye be not deceived: for many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and the time draweth near: go ye not therefore after them." (Luke 21:8 KJV) He warned them about the coming of the false Christ, that will come to deceive the Jewish nation and even the disciples and to pull them into wrong directions. The false Christ will aim to draw the people toward them. Jesus warned them not to follow them when He said, go ye not therefore after them.

The false Christ when they would come they will be also persecuted by the Jewish who will not believe on them. So someone will say how we can differentiate them if they will appear now for they will be even persecuted? That is why we need to be careful and to discern to follow the right doctrine and the right way of life that based on the Scriptures. We need to continue to read the Scriptures and to apply them in our lives. The Scriptures will reveal to us God's will and the truth that we are called to live on.

- "9 But when ye shall hear of wars and commotions, be not terrified: for these things must first come to pass; but the end is not by and by." (Luke 21:9 KJV) Jesus mentioned to them that they will be hearing news about wars and commotions (turmoil and disorders), but He told them not to be terrified, because these must come, but the end is not yet. God when He move to judge, He will mobilize His armies and forces, and that is why we hear news of wars and fights, but that is not the end but the beginning. So we need to be prepared for such events and be willing to bear what will be taking place.
- "10 Then said he unto them, Nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom." (Luke 21:10 KJV) These news of wars will be followed by a nation rising against another nation, and a kingdom against another kingdom. These events are escalations and confirmation on the coming judgment of God on the disobedient people who refuse to comply with His will and plan.
- "11 And great earthquakes shall be in divers places, and famines, and pestilences; and fearful sights and great signs shall there be from heaven." (Luke 21:11 KJV) Natural calamities, and terrible events in various places with famines and sickness, plagues and epidemic are going to take place. These are signs that God is judging the disobedient.
- "12 But before all these, they shall lay their hands on you, and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues, and into prisons, being brought before kings and rulers for my name's sake." (Luke 21:12 KJV) Jesus is telling His disciples here that they will be persecuted and got delivered into prisons and synagogues and even they will stand before kings for the sake of His Jesus, The apostle were persecuted and the Jewish laid their hands on them and used the non believers kings to bring troubles on them as we can read in the following Scriptures when the Jewish persecuted the apostles: "1 And as they spake unto the people, the priests, and the captain of the temple, and the Sadducees, came upon them, 2 Being grieved that they taught the people, and preached through Jesus the resurrection from the dead. 3 And they laid hands on them, and put them in hold unto the next day: for it was now eventide. 4 Howbeit many of them which heard the word believed; and the number of the men was about five thousand. 5 And it came to pass on the morrow, that their rulers, and elders, and scribes, 6 And Annas the high priest, and Caiaphas, and John, and Alexander, and as many as were of the kindred of the high priest, were gathered together at Jerusalem. 7 And when they had set them in the midst, they asked, By what power, or by what name, have ye done this? 8 Then Peter, filled with the Holy Ghost, said unto them, Ye rulers of the people, and elders of Israel, 9 If we this day be examined of the good deed done to the impotent man, by what means he is made whole; 10 Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole. 11 This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner. 12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved. 13 Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marvelled; and they took knowledge of them, that they had been with Jesus. 14 And beholding the man which was healed standing with them, they could say nothing against it. 15 But when they had commanded them to go aside out of the council, they conferred among themselves, 16 Saying, What shall we do to these men? for that indeed a notable miracle hath been done by them is manifest to all them that dwell in Jerusalem; and we cannot deny it. 17 But that it spread no further among the people, let us straitly threaten them, that they speak henceforth to no man in this name. 18 And they called them, and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus." (Acts 4:1-18 KJV) The same persecution taken place when Stephan was stoned and the church in Jerusalem persecuted, "And Saul was consenting unto his death. And at that time there was a great persecution against the church which was at Jerusalem; and they were all scattered abroad throughout the regions of Judaea and Samaria, except the apostles." (Acts 8:1 KJV) By persecution James killed and Peter arrested by Herod the king and was prepared for trial, "Now about that time Herod the king stretched forth his hands to vex certain of the church. 2 And he killed James the brother of John with the sword. 3 And because he saw it pleased the Jews, he proceeded further to take Peter also. (Then were the days of unleavened bread.) 4 And when he had apprehended him, he put him in prison, and delivered him to four quaternions of soldiers to keep him; intending after Easter to bring him forth to the people." (Acts 12:1-4 KJV) So Jesus was telling them what is ahead of them of persecution, before His coming judgment on the Jewish that rejected Him. In the same way, as God would judge those who do not want to follow His Word and decrees, we too today would expect persecution and troubles from those who hate Christ and who hate His Word. Certain times when we minister to the people, they will hate us because we rebuked them for their sins. They may fight against us and try to hurt us. They may not be able to do that because we might be protected by God through certain facilities or governments

rules that hindering them to do that, but finally we will be passing through real persecution and got hurt by those who hate God and His Word.

- "13 And it shall turn to you for a testimony." (Luke 21:13 KJV) Jesus told His disciples that these will take a place so that you will be having opportunity to minister to those people about Jesus. Persecution will come into our lives and this will be our new opportunity to minister to the people and to tell them about Jesus Christ, our Lord.
- "14 Settle it therefore in your hearts, not to meditate before what ye shall answer: 15 For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist." (Luke 21:14-15 KJV) Jesus assured His disciples and He is assuring us today that we don't need to be worried of what we need to think to speak and how to answer them. Because Jesus promised that He will give us mouth and wisdom that no one will be able to oppose, contradict, argue or resist.
- "16 And ye shall be betrayed both by parents, and brethren, and kinsfolks, and friends; and some of you shall they cause to be put to death. 17 And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake." (Luke 21:16-17 KJV) Jesus explained to the disciples that after the events of the persecution with the outsider, then will come upon them another event of persecution from those insiders; those who are part of their families, relatives and friends. Jesus told them that those people who are near to you will hate you and you will be betrayed by parents, brothers and sisters, by relatives and even by friends that they trust. Even to the point of death. So the persecution that the disciples, and we among them, is to be hated from the outsider people, but later on the persecution will involve us persecution from inside in our families, relatives and friends. Even today we are in threat and dangers of certain people that we are reaching out correcting and dealing with using God's Word. Certain time persecution will be hindered and not clear to us because there are rules of governments that prevent crimes, otherwise long time we will be beaten and killed even.
- "18 But there shall not an hair of your head perish." (Luke 21:18 KJV) By that what Jesus told them and He means that nothing will take place without His permission. Even one hair of our head God will not allow to fall without His permission. That is why we are protected and preserved to continue to testify and witness to Him.
- "19 In your patience possess ye your souls." (Luke 21:19 KJV) He instructed His apostles to be patience and persevering in their endeavor to serve Him and to continue to follow His steps and apply His Word in their lives. He told them when you will be keen to do that and persevere in suffering then your souls will be saved. "For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life for my sake shall find it." (Matthew 16:25 KJV)
- "20 And when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies, then know that the desolation thereof is nigh." (Luke 21:20 KJV) The disciples needed to be passing through all these trials and troubles in their endeavour to preach the Gospel in Jerusalem before expecting to see the coming judgment of God upon Jerusalem and the Jewish church by the coming of the Romans army against them. He told them, when the armies would surround Jerusalem then that will be the time to destroy His temple by the chosen army that God sent to them.
- "21 Then let them which are in Judaea flee to the mountains; and let them which are in the midst of it depart out; and let not them that are in the countries enter thereinto." (Luke 21:21 KJV) Jesus warned His disciples that when they will see that taking place, if they are in Judaea let them go further and flee to the mountains, and if they are in Jerusalem they should leave and go outside Jerusalem, and those who are in the other places should not come in to hide in Jerusalem. He is warning them that they cannot trust and hide in Jerusalem being a strong city and can resist. He warned His disciples that they cannot trust and hide in Jerusalem because Jerusalem have the Temple of God. He is telling them that the city of Jerusalem will not be able to stand against the armies that He is going to send against to destroy her. Jesus gave His disciples the instruction of what they need to do when the armies appear to besiege Jerusalem. He instructed them to flee away so their lives will be saved and the Gospel will be preached in other nations. This instruction to flee from Jerusalem is opposite to the believes of the Jewish who trusted in Jerusalem and in the temple of Jerusalem. They did not believe in Jesus, but they put their trust on the Temple of God in Jerusalem. In their mind that God will not allow His temple to be destroyed. Therefore when the Romans armies on 70 AD came against them all the Christian left Jerusalem for they listened to the Word of Jesus and obeyed them, but the Jewish who despised the Word of Jesus, they remained and all killed and destroyed. Even today this can be applied to us. God will send His wrath to discipline the wicked and to punish them, so when we commit ourselves and follow His instructions we will be saved and spared troubles, but if we continue to follow our own sinful traditions and stubborn ways then we will meet with the destructions that He is sending to destroy the wicked.
- "22 For these be the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled." (Luke 21:22 KJV) Jesus said so to describe the events of the coming destruction and the coming judgment of God on the obstinate nation, the Jewish church, that were opposing Christ and His Word and His mission. Jesus declared to them, For these be the days of vengeance; Jesus used the word vengeance to address what He is going to do and how to deal with His own people who rejected His Word and His ways. Even today, God will send His vengeance against His people, His church, who are resisting His Word and defying His will in their lives. The Lord may tarry waiting, but He will not let the wicked go unpunished if they will not repent.
- "23 But woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck, in those days! for there shall be great distress in the land, and wrath upon this people." (Luke 21:23 KJV) Jesus telling them that those who are pregnant and those who give suck, will be hard to them, because it will be very difficult for them to flee, because of the vast distress that God will allow to take place in order to

judge those who opposed and refused the Word of Christ. So what is understood, that when God will bring His judgment, there will be even no consideration upon those who are in a critical physical condition. Many they think that Christ is soft and gentle and He will not deal forcefully with sin. But that is not correct. The time will come and the Lord Jesus will judge the sins of His people forcefully.

"24 And they shall fall by the edge of the sword, and shall be led away captive into all nations: and Jerusalem shall be trodden down of the Gentiles, until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled." (Luke 21:24 KJV) This would be the outcome of the Jewish nation who opposed Christ. They will be killed by the edge of the sword, and they shall be tracked captive to be prisoners and work as slaves. Jerusalem was surely destroyed by the Gentiles, who destroyed Jerusalem by the Romans army on 70 AD. This situation came upon Jerusalem while the gospel continued to be proclaimed to other nations. The wrath of God that He brought against Jerusalem by the coming og the Romans army, helped to scatter the Christians in Jerusalem and led them to spread to other nations and they preached the Word of God to them. When Jesus said, "until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled." What He means that the wrath of God that He will send against Jerusalem, the same wrath will help the Christians to spread the Gospel to the other nations.

"25 And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring." (Luke 21:25 KJV) These are not necessary physical signs in heaven but a literal in a figurative sense.

when Jesus said, "And there shall be signs in the sun," the sun is the glory of God, in his temple. After Jesus' Jesus death on the cross God had departed from this people, yet the token of the divine presence remained till the utter destruction of the temple; and then when the temple was totally destroyed in 70 AD by the Romans empire, this sun was wholly darkened, and there was not so much as the outward symbol of it.

And when Jesus said, "and in the moon," which also is to be explained in a figurative and metaphorical sense; the ceremonial law of Moses is the moon, of the Jewish church, who practice the daily sacrifices and that continued till the temple destroyed.

And when Jesus said, "and in the stars," the stars are the teachers of the church that will cease from speaking, for what they will say after the destruction of the Temple. The teachers of the Law had put themselves and their traditions above the Word of God, so God destroyed their traditions by destroying the temple and Jerusalem and He silenced them, being scattered to other countries and nations as servants and prisoners. They were perplexed and in distress to what God had brought upon them. The same God will do the same with the churches who run relying on certain traditional things and practices and not on the Word of God. The time will come when God will destroy what they put their trust on.

"26 Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken." (Luke 21:26 KJV) The hearts of men will fail them due to what is happening from catastrophic events that had affected Judaea, Jerusalem and the temple. for the powers of heaven shall be shaken meaning all the ordinances of the legal dispensation; which shaking, and even removing of them, were foretold by the Prophet Haggai, "For thus saith the LORD of hosts; Yet once, it is a little while, and I will shake the heavens, and the earth, and the sea, and the dry land." (Haggai 2:6) and explained by the author of the Epistle to the Hebrews, "26 Whose voice then shook the earth: but now he hath promised, saying, Yet once more I shake not the earth only, but also heaven. 27 And this word, Yet once more, signifieth the removing of those things that are shaken, as of things that are made, that those things which cannot be shaken may remain." (Hebrews 12:26-27 KJV) Theough the judgment of God on Jerusalem, room and way were made for Gospel ordinances to take place, and be established; which shall not be shaken, so as to be removed, but remain till the second coming of Christ. In the same way, God in bringing His judgment on the churches that disobey Him will give the way for the Gospel to be preached to other nations.

"27 And then shall they see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power and great glory." (Luke 21:27 KJV) He shall appear, not in person, but in the power of His wrath and vengeance. The punishment that God will afflict on the Jewish nation on that day it will be related to the coming Jesus with vengeance against them. In the same way the time will come, that Jesus will inflict vengeance on those who opposed Jesus and who persecuting us by continuing sinning and living against the truth of God.

"28 And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh." (Luke 21:28 KJV) When all that would take place, then He was telling His disciples that they will be free from now onward from the persecution of the Jewish people. To what would take place, by the coming of the Romans army against Jerusalem, they will be saved by Jesus from all the troubles that the Jewish had inflicted on them. Jesus is instructing them when this all will take place, let them rejoice, look up and lift up their head up and rejoice. In the same way for us, there will be a time, that what we suffered from persecution because of the sins of the body of Christ, we will be set free from it and we will be rejoicing.

"29 And he spake to them a parable; Behold the fig tree, and all the trees; 30 When they now shoot forth, ye see and know of your own selves that summer is now nigh at hand. 31 So likewise ye, when ye see these things come to pass, know ye that the kingdom of God is nigh at hand." (Luke 21:29-31 KJV) He explained further to His disciples that what He will do to his enemies will be so visible as the shooting forth of the fig tree or other trees on Summer. And that when it will take place they will be aware that the Kingdom of God is prevailing, God is doing His will and Christ's church is progressing, and a more visible and glorious display of the kingdom of the Messiah, will be seen in the destruction of his enemies

"32 Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass away, till all be fulfilled." (Luke 21:32 KJV) Jesus asserted to His disciples that the generation of the Jewish who persecuted Him and crucified Him, the same generation will suffer the vengeance of God and His wrath upon the city and the temple. "33 Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away." (Luke 21:33 KJV) God shall fulfill His Word and accomplish what He had promised to those who hated him, by sending them destruction, and to those who obeyed Him He will give them reward and progress.

"34 And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares." (Luke 21:34 KJV) Now here Jesus gave warning to His disciples, as well as, He is warning us from the followings:

- 1. The *hearts to be overcharged with surfeiting*: The heart to be cheated with the indulgence of food, drink and delicacies. We should not indulge ourselves much with food and drink and move our focus from heavenly things to the desire of the flesh.
- 2. The *hearts to be overcharged with drunkenness*: drinking and ingestion of alcohol in order to forget or to escape facing the real issues of life.
- 3. The *hearts to be overcharged with the cares of this life*; the worries and the unnecessary over thinking. We should do our part, and trust God's Word and what He promised. After we do our part, we should not worry about what will take place after.

"35 For as a snare shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth." (Luke 21:35 KJV) These things are like snares that will hook and trap the disciples from following God. We need to be aware and move away from such things. We need always to check and examine ourselves and see clearly how God is moving in fulfilling His Word and His plan.

"36 Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man." (Luke 21:36 KJV) We need to watch ourselves and pray and draw near to God, to be always ready to move on time and do the right things, as God is moving to deal with those who reject Him and to reward us, that the time will come when we will be found worthy of His reward and escaping the wrath that He will send to His enemies.

My dear and beloved: "32 But of that day and that hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels which are in heaven, neither the Son, but the Father. 33 Take ye heed, watch and pray: for ye know not when the time is. 34 For the Son of Man is as a man taking a far journey, who left his house, and gave authority to his servants, and to every man his work, and commanded the porter to watch. 35 Watch ye therefore: for ye know not when the master of the house cometh, at even, or at midnight, or at the cockcrowing, or in the morning: 36 Lest coming suddenly he find you sleeping. 37 And what I say unto you I say unto all, Watch." (Mark 13:32-37 KJV) "Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed is he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame." (Revelation 16:15 KJV)

Put it in your mind. The Lord knows how to catch those who do wrong and hide their sins. The Lord shall catch such workers and disciples, and will deal with their wrong doing in a day and moment they will not be expectant of it, "50 The lord of that servant shall come in a day when he looketh not for him, and in an hour that he is not aware of, 51 And shall cut him asunder, and appoint him his portion with the hypocrites: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth." (Matthew 24:50-51 KJV) He will cut them; either they will be put to death, that is why we can see death taken place, and God is taking certain people all of a sudden from the scene. Or they will be taken out suddenly from all their privileges as judgment to their sins and He will be put them and assigned them place with the hypocrites, and with the liars, for they will be exposed, and their sins will be discovered and the mask will be take away from their faces.

The Lord also knows how to reward His people, those who serve Him and those who do His will and walk in His ways. Those when He will come and see them in the place and the ministry that He assigned for them to do; when He will come and will see them doing their responsibilities toward those under their care and the people around them, the Lord shall reward those servants and promote them and add to them blessings, strength, privileges, and ministries. Those who continue persevering in the place that God had assigned to them to be, one day they will receive what is for them and their rewards from the Lord as they continue to serve Him and do His will.
